ALL ABOUT OUR CLASS BUBBLES

These are the things we are doing to keep your child safe:-

Playground zones. A class stays strictly in a zone for a week. A supervisor is attached to a zone.

Classes stay in their rooms for lessons, meals and if it's wet, "wet play".

A class bubble has an assigned toilet and each child has an individual storage basket.

Regular hand washing first thing and before break and lunch. Sanitiser used in between times.

After school clubs are in class bubbles.
